7.3 It is not intended that all the requirements contained herein should be applied to every program. Portions of this DID are subject to deletion tailoring depending upon the program phase in which it is applied in the contract.

7.4 This DID is related to and used with DI-ILSS-80813 , List Logistic Technical Data Users.

Block 10, Preparation Instructions (Continued)

10.1.1.4 Usage circumstance. The circumstances under which the information will be used, as related to the operational scenario. Examples are; support of ship alterations (SHIPALT) development or installation, intermediate maintenance activity (IMA) support, depot level repairs, etc. Identify the specific types of information that each user will require.

10.1.1.5 End-use category. For each activity, the type and detail of the information required shall be categorized as to end use. Examples of these categories are given below. The complete list of categories shall be as defined in the individual user profiles and information requirements. In addition, any preconditions on the content, format, or media of the information imposed by each user activity shall be identified.

- a. Acquisition program management
- b. LTD program management
- c. Maintenance management
- d. Equipment operation
- e. Supply support management
- f. Training
- g. Troubleshooting and Repair and repair
- h. Configuration management
- i. Installation and checkout
- j. Testing
- k. Alteration planning
- l. Mockup design

10.1.2 Specific requirements. The profile shall contain a title page, table of contents, and four sections as follows:

10.1.2.1 Title page. The title page shall identify the report title, security classification, contract number, and effective date.

Block 10. Preparation Instructions (Continued)

10.1.2.2 Table of contents. The table of contents shall identify each section and titled paragraph.

10.1.2.3 Section 1. Methodology. Describe the methodology used to develop the users profiles.

10.1.2.4 Section 2. User profile. This section shall contain the profiles of all activities expected to receive and use LTD products to be generated under the contract or acquisition. (For NAVSEA only) All shore-based activities only.

10.1.2.6 Section 4. Summary matrix. The information detailed in section 2 and 3 shall be summarized in a matrix. The matrix shall correlate identified education levels, skill levels, environment conditions, usage circumstances, and end-use categories to the list of identified LTD users.

10.2 Format requirements. The profiles and summary matrix shall be in contractor format on 8 1/2" x 11" paper (metric size A4), using 10 point modern bold type.
